## Rail jam, DJ contests at XOS Battle & Winterfest

It's the guys versus the gals during two days of high energy snowboarding, fashion and music at the first XOS "Battle of the Sexes Winterfest" on February 3-4.

On the slopes Bear Mountain hosts male vs. female snowboarding competitions in The Scene on Feb. 4 along with live music and winter fashion show featuring athletic gear and apparel Saturday and Sunday.

Away from the resort there's the first annual Winterfest in the Village on Saturday. From 11 a.m.-6 p.m. there's free entertainment, local and national vendors, food and interactive family activities. Highlights include ice sculpting contests and rock climbing, kids snow play zone, face painting, snowshoe demos, carnival-style games, soup cookoff and more.

After dark on both Friday and Saturday the party moves inside the structured tent for dueling male and female DJ concerts and dance floor. Headlining acts include internationally-renowned DJs Revolv, Tatianna Fontes and Kristina Sky. Other performers include 2Deadbeatz, Duality, Shibby, MC2 and Ayla Simone.

The tented events provide entertaining male vs. female DJ battles, dance-offs and catwalk fashion struts for ages 18 and over from 5 p.m.-midnight. Admission to the tented parties is \$25 each night and a portion of ticket sales goes to Boarding for Breast Cancer. Call (800) 424-4232.

## Get 'Snowed In' at Bear with Mac Miller concert

Get "Snowed In" at Bear with hip-hop rap artist Mac Miller during Power 106's party on Saturday, February 11.

The slopeside party on the 13,000 sq. ft. deck features a free live performance by Miller, known for hits like "Donald Trump" which has had over 27 million views on YouTube and peaked at #40 on iTunes. Last fall "Blue Slide Park" debuted #1 on the Billboard 200. Also on tap Feb. 11 is the Never Summer snowboard demo.

Sounds are flying as much as the snow at both Bear Mountain and also Snow Summit. "Saturday's at the Board Room" live concert series at Bear continues this month with blues and rock by Amorist at Large and The Galaxy Kids on Feb. 4 from 2-6 p.m. A week later on Feb. 11 enjoy rock by Soul of the River from 3-7 p.m. On Feb. 18 it's reggae with High Tide and then Contagious takes the stage for rock and roll on Feb. 25. Voodoo Fix plays blues and rock on March 3. Admission is free.

Join your favorite radio stations for sounds and swag at the resorts, including KROQ on Feb. 3 and 17, Feb. 10 Rock 105 live remote, plus KCXX on the mountain at Bear on Feb. 12. Jack FM San Diego is on Summit's VIP deck from noon-4 p.m. on Feb. 4 with 94.1 KMYI at the resort on Feb. 5. 98.7 brings a live band on Feb. 11 with KROQ spinning sounds on Feb. 10 and 24.

## Salomon BBR Demos on Feb. 18-20, 25-26

Check out the distinctly different Salomon BBR shovel-tipped skis for free during two demo weekends this month at Snow Summit.

Wide at the tip and rockered for float, narrow underfoot with normal camber for carving, and then girthy again in the tails—the BBR was designed by the same ski engineer who came up with Salomon's legendary X Scream. It's meant to be a one-ski quiver that can carve groomers yet still surf through powder, crud and chop.

Just leave a credit card at the demo booth and find out for yourself if it lives up to the hype during three big days over President's Day weekend on Feb. 18-20 plus a week later Feb. 25-26.

## 'Go Huck Yourself' events at Summit, Bear

Thanks to weather cancellations there's not one but two "Go Huck Yourself" series events in February.

Each resort hosts "Go Huck Yourself" events starting with Bear Mountain on Feb. 11 under the lights in The Scene. Hot iron twilight action on the rails is on tap with music and giveaways starting at 4 p.m.

Two weeks later it's Snow Summit's turn as "Go Huck Yourself" returns with its traditional big air flair on Saturday, Feb. 25. Big air is maybe an understatement as riders huck big down a jump line on Westridge from 6-9 p.m. There's plenty of hot drinks and sounds with DJ plus tons of swag to go with the action in a low key but high-flying show.

"Go Huck Yourself" entry is free for those with a lift ticket. Register two hours prior to each event in the Board Room at Bear and Bear Bottom Lodge at Snow Summit. Call (909) 866-5766.

## Get Skilled at Bear Camp Ski, Board Sessions

Spend a day in The People's Park with top Bear Mountain coaches—complete with video analysis—during Bear Camp ski and snowboard sessions.

Each fully coached, on snow session from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. focuses on skills that come into play throughout the mountain, from the park and pipe to steeps. Bear Camp is for beginner through advanced riders who choose sessions that include free riding, jumps, rails, lap park and halfpipe. Get your skiing and riding where you want it to be by utilizing Bear's nationally recognized terrain parks and pipe.

Sessions are set for every Saturday and Sunday through March 25. Cost is \$139 with lift ticket or \$99 for those with a season pass and participants get lunch and retail discounts too. (909) 866-5766.
